

Privacy Policy

Scope

1. Data Controller

3. Information collected and purpose Download Information.

When you visit our website the following information will be automatically processed and solely for the use by Campus Hub Malta:

- *the operating system of the machine running your web browser and the type and version of your web browser.*

5. Personal data provided by the data subject
